

SUCCeSS Support for Conference Organization

Stockholm University Center for Circular and Sustainable Systems (SUCCeSS) aims to promote broad transdisciplinary research, in collaboration with industry and policymakers. We now launch a support for conference organization related to any of the three SUCCeSS research focus areas **Circular and sustainable processing, Data driven circular and sustainable chemistry, and Circular and safe food and water systems.**

Support can be given for the organization of conferences or conference sessions, where SUCCeSS will be well visible and presented briefly.

Eligible applicants: The call targets PIs and researchers at SU.

Time period: Applications should be submitted to SUCCeSS well in time before the conference, and no later than Dec 15th 2026.

Available funding: 50 000 - 100 000 SEK per proposal. The call will fund a maximum of 5-6 applications.

Evaluation & Decision:

Applications will be evaluated on a continuous basis, within 15 days of submission, by the SUCCeSS Executive Committee (EC). If there is a conflict of interest (CoI), the chair of the board will assign the evaluation to other board members. The EC will decide whether to fund the application and report the status of the call at the board meetings under “Director’s report”.

The evaluation will be based on the criteria below, where the numbering reflects the order to importance:

- 1) Conferences should be related to sustainability and circularity within SUCCeSS’ research focus areas, preferably with an interdisciplinary approach.
- 2) Nationally and internationally reputed conferences will be supported.
- 3) PIs requesting the funds should be part of the organization at conference level or session level.

**Demands on grant receivers:**

- SUCCeSS should be presented at the conference, e.g. at the beginning of the sponsored session.
- SUCCeSS banner should be on stage during the session, and the logotype should be visible on the conference website and program.
- The applicant needs to join the [SUCCeSS community](#)

The application should include:

A) Conference plan: A short description of the planned conference, including website link, where the relation to the SUCCeSS focus areas is explained, and with a clear plan how SUCCeSS will be promoted in the event. The role of the applicant in the conference organization should be stated. A detailed budget should also be included (1 page).

B) Applicant CV (1 page)

Application submission: email the files above as a single PDF document to SUCCeSS administration (info.success@su.se). Write "SUCCeSS Conference Organization Grant" in the subject line.

Requisition of funding: Request the approved funding within 15 days after the conference, through email to info.success@su.se. Provide a report of the conference including 3 selected conference photographs where SUCCeSS is clearly visible (1 page). Presentation links and recordings may be also provided whenever possible.
