

Asthma/allergy considerations in the resource rooms

Studenthuset (house Beta) has 12 resource rooms specially adapted for students with long-term disabilities. The rooms have no plants and are sparsely furnished in order to minimise dust accumulation. The rooms are cleaned every weekday morning according to the following schedule:

Floors	Cleaning	Once a day
Carpets	Vacuuming	Once a day
Tables & window sills	Cleaning and trash removal	Once a day
Door frames, skirtings	Cleaning	Once a month

Student Services cannot guarantee that the resource rooms are completely free from allergenic particles. Traces of allergenic substances can always occur, since hundreds of students are using the rooms. For example, pet hair and the smell of smoke and/or perfume may be brought in through students' clothing.

The rules posted in each resource room encourage students to show consideration for those with allergies by avoiding perfume and keeping an eye on clothes with pet hair. The rules also stipulate that it is prohibited to eat warm, cooked food in the resource rooms, as the smell of the food may bother other students. Students are not permitted to bring nuts or other foods that are highly allergenic. Compliance with these rules is based on trust and difficult to check.

No trash bins are available in the rooms since 30 March 2015. Students must bring all trash with them from the room and dispose of it at the nearest recycling station, for example in house Alfa.
