## THE IGELÖSA HOARD

When the verger Jöns Jönsson was digging a grave c. 60 m. north of the tower of Igelösa church, Igelösa par., Skåne, on 10th July 1924, he found at a depth of c. 1 metre a lump of metal, which proved to consist of coins. The hoard thus discovered was redeemed and now belongs to KMK but is deposited in the coin cabinet in the Historical Museum of the University of Lund. A list mainly by mints was made for the inventory archives, while the list published below was made in 1972 and based on the coins preserved in Lund with the addition of the 43 coins (40 Anglo-Saxon and 3 Hiberno-Norse) which were retained in KMK, but of these latter only 38 can now be identified in KMK.

The original list states that there were, in addition to a fragment of a silver brooch, 2,034 whole and c. 23 fragments of coins making a total of 2,057. The present list numbers 2,039 coins (excluding minor fragments). The discrepancy is probably mainly due to how the fragments were counted but there are also other real differences such as the fact that only 12 Arabic dirhams have been preserved while 13 is the figure given in the inventory. For some mints there are also more coins preserved than stated in the list and it is clear that the inventory list is not quite reliable. The present list may also include some errors, however, as it has not been possible to make a final check. Some of the Anglo-Saxon coins will probably also be transferred to the Scandinavian series when a more detailed list is made.

In the collection of the coin cabinet in Lund there is also a small parcel of coins with no inventory number or any other information to indicate when or how it was acquired. The coins are not listed in the inventory but the composition of the parcel makes it likely that they form part of the hoard and they are listed here as nos. 2040-53.

One coin belonging to Kulturen in Lund (no. 1623 below) which was acquired with the information that it was found in Igelösa (Inventory no. 39.784), also indicates that not all coins in the hoard were redeemed.

There is only one larger hoard with Anglo-Saxon coins from Sweden and that is the Äspinge hoard (DS 108) with 3,047 coins. A summary of the Anglo-Saxon element is set out on the next page.

The hoard must consist of several parcels of which two large ones may be associated with danegelds which makes it foremost among the (surprisingly few) hoards that can be said to consist of danegeld payments. The very high proportion of Anglo-Saxon coins (87%) is also unique for a large hoard. The latest coin in the hoard is an arabic dirham struck 1003/4 which is not out of line with the Anglo-Saxon coins which include pieces of the late Subsidiary Long Cross. The hoard was probably concealed c. 1005.

The Arabic coins have been attributed by Gert Rispling and the German by Peter Berghaus.

The summary on the opposite page shows the composition of the Anglo-Saxon part.
