Viking Olov Björk's scholarship supports research in the **intersection between medical technology and its close to clinical applications**. This covers research and development within such areas as **tissue engineering, nanotechnology or biomaterial research**.

The National Humanities Center invites applications for its residential fellowships. These support scholars who want to undertake advanced studies in the **humanities** at the NHC and individuals from the natural and **social sciences, the arts, the professions and public life who are engaged in humanistic projects**. Most of the fellowships are unrestricted, though a few are focused on particular areas of research, including fellowships for environmental studies, English literature, art history, Asian studies, theology and for early-career female philosophers. It is expected that the fellow's home institution will cover the remaining salary.

NordForsk: NOK 120 million for interdisciplinary research

Deadline for submissions is **13 November 2019**

NordForsk's new programme will promote high-quality interdisciplinary research that combines and integrate skills from multiple disciplines.

Interdisciplinarity is widely acknowledged as essential to the generation of new and ground-breaking research results, and interdisciplinary research is an obvious area in which Nordic collaboration will generate added value. The call is specifically aimed at genuinely interdisciplinary projects that combine disciplines which are far removed from one another and rarely collaborate, or that pursue an original research question requiring the exact combination of competencies from different disciplines proposed in the application. Projects awarded funding must include at least two of the following three areas of science: Life science, Physical Sciences & Engineering, and Social Sciences and Humanities.

The maximum funding that may be sought per project is NOK 15 million, and NordForsk hopes to fund 8 - 12 research projects under this call. Funding will be granted for up to four years, and successful proposals must include partners from at least three Nordic countries.

The Nordic Programme for Interdisciplinary Research is a collaborative effort between the Academy of Finland, the Independent Research Fund Denmark, the Swedish Research Council, the Research Council of Norway, and NordForsk.
