The Association of European Marine Biological Laboratories invites applications for its ASSEMBLE plus call.

This enables researchers to **access over 30 marine biological research institutions** across Europe and overseas to carry out scientific research in the field of marine biological sciences. Funding is provided to access laboratories, state-of-the-art experimental facilities and technological platforms, ecosystems and a wide variety of marine biological resources. Teams of up to two researchers are supported. PhD students, postdoctoral researchers or engineers may apply. They must work or study in a recognised academic institution, be employed by a non-profit organisation or registered company. Their home institutions must be based in an EU member state or associated country, with priority given to new users and those from outside the ASSEMBLE plus network. Researchers may only apply to visit ASSEMBLE sites outside their own country. Proposals from SMEs are especially encouraged. Master's students can participate in a transactional access project if this is led by an experienced researcher but travel and subsistence costs of these students are not reimbursed. Successful candidates gain access to the ASSEMBLE plus research infrastructure, receive round trip travel, subsistence and the shipping of material needed for the project worth up to €400.
