

Course Evaluation for the course Human Rights and Education, 7,5 hp

Number of students who passed the course: 17
<p><i>Changes to the course since last year:</i></p> <p>Included a supervision seminar on students research topics for course papers and an additional seminar at the beginning of the course with supervision of searching relevant earlier research in relation to the students research interests in the field.</p>
<p><i>The strengths of the course (based on the quantitative results and written comments given in the course evaluation):</i></p> <p>67% of the students found the lectures in each session very good and 60% of the students found the course as a whole very good.</p>
<p><i>The weaknesses of the course (based on the quantitative results and written comments given in the course evaluation):</i></p> <p>40% of the students found the course literature very good. Here the students asked for course literature on the right to education and not only on human rights education as well as less philosophical content.</p>
<p><i>The lecturer's analysis of the evaluation:</i></p> <p>The course is very appreciated since the students answered that they didn't want to change anything in the course except having more time, especially in the final seminar.</p>
