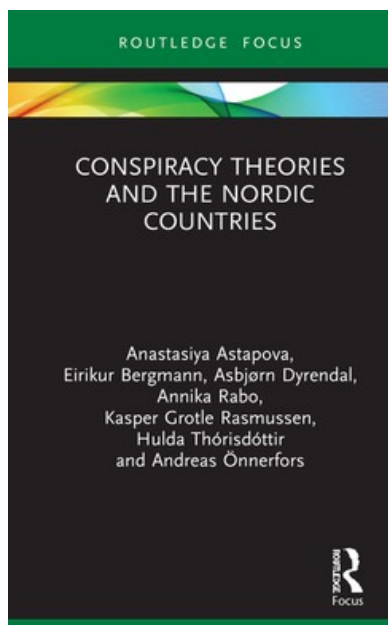


Conspiracy Theories and the Nordic Countries
