Important information regarding admission to the latter part of a program

Admission is possible to the second year of all our master programs, as well as the third year of the Bachelor program in physics or the Medical Physics program. You must meet the prerequisites of the program in question to be admitted to the latter part. The requirements are given on our web page: <u>www.fysik.su.se</u>

A summary of necessary documentation is given below. Note that if you do not provide this information, your application may be judged incomplete and will not be processed. Further information is available on our web pages.

• Documentation showing that you meet the requirements for admission to the first year of the program.

• Documentation of your previous university-level studies; a transcript of records and/or a degree certificate.

• Relevant course plans or syllabi from previous and ongoing studies at other universities (not SU). If documents describing your previous courses are missing, we cannot assess your previous studies and you will not be able to meet the admission requirements.

NB! Results which are available through universityadmissions.se or reported in Ladok (at SU) do not need to be included. Instead you can check the corresponding box above. Please note that it is your responsibility to make sure that any such results are reported correctly. If anything is missing or incorrect, contact the university in charge of the course.

In case we receive more applications than we can admit to the program, a selection will be made among the applicants. This will be based on the results from previous university studies.

Transfer of credits from previous studies

Admission to the latter part of a program does not mean that your previous studies are automatically transferred to the program, nor is the assessment of your previous studies made a decision regarding credit transferal. Only a student at Stockholm University is eligible to apply for credit transferal. Please note that transferal is not always needed; courses from other Swedish universities can often be included directly in a degree. Please see our web pages or contact the academic advisor for more information.
