

Travel grant time line for PhD students

1) Liljevalch's and Augustinsson's Travel Grants

What: courses or meetings
When: Opens mid January /
Deadline mid February /
Notification beginning of May
How much: up to ~13.000 SEK
Conditions: first year of PhD completed, younger than 35 years old, course/meeting has to be attended within 1 year from the day of decision

3) Travel grant K & A Wallenberg Foundation

What: courses or meetings
When: Opens in August /
Deadline mid September /
Notification in October
How much: up to ~13.000 SEK
Conditions: course/meeting has to be attended within 1 year from the day of decision

2) Donation Scholarships

What: courses or meetings, research trips, in exceptions even materials
When: Opens mid March /
Deadline mid April /
Notification in June
How much: up to ~24.000 SEK
Conditions: money has to be spent between September and August of the following year

4) Sture Eriksson's Fund for Cancer and Heart research

What: courses, meetings or short research stays abroad
When: Opens in September /
Deadline mid October
Conditions: course/meeting/research stay has to be related to cancer or heart research

General information

Grant applications are ranked by the prefect of the department and assessed by the stipend committee. There is usually no need for long essays or multi-page CVs but make sure to include all the most important information, also about the course or meeting you want to attend. The final results are usually announced a few months after the respective deadline.

Even if you don't need or want a travel grant you should still apply! Why? If more people from MBW apply, MBW will get more travel grants. If you want to support your fellow PhD students, simply write an application for a relevant course or conference and send an email to the prefect of MBW (currently Neus Visa, neus.visa@su.se) and let them know that they should rank you last.
