International opportunities for doctoral students





Grant from the Department of Psychology

- Each doctoral student receives SEK 20,000. All or part of the sum can be used for travel relevant to the education, e.g. stay at a research lab, scientific conference or data collection.
- Doctoral students can apply for a travel grant from their division. Heads of departments (possibly in consultation with senior researchers) distribute the funds.



Funding through EU/Erasmus+

Doctoral students can apply for Erasmus+ scholarships in all four mobility categories:

- [Erasmus+ student mobility – studies](#)
5-30 days or 2-12 months
- [Erasmus+ student mobility – internship](#)
5-30 days or 2-12 months
e.g. research experience, data collection and writing the dissertation
alternatively internship after the doctoral studies
- [Erasmus+ teacher mobility](#)
2-60 days, at least 8 teaching hours/week
- [Erasmus+ staff training \(not research\)](#)
2-5 days
e.g. job shadowing, workshops, shorter courses

Departmental agreements are required for student mobility (studies) and teacher mobility. Read more on [SU's website](#).
