Webcast Workshop on Non-Response in Surveys

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Non-response is an increasing problem in social surveys, and particularly difficult to handle in longitudinal panel studies. The good news is that research on non-response is a vibrant area. We now have both better understanding of the effects of non-response and some tools for identification and mitigation of the adverse effects of non-response. The workshop will provide up-to-date knowledge for researchers and practitioners. We have invited some of the best researchers in the field. Most of them are also vastly experienced in practical issues of non-response in surveys.

The workshop will be webcast and registered participants will be able to attend the entire workshop as well as send in their questions online. A small number of practitioners have also been personally invited to take part physically if the pandemic situation allows.

The workshop is primarily aimed at researchers and practitioners working with survey studies or using survey data in a Swedish context, but the language will be English and international participants are welcome to attend.
