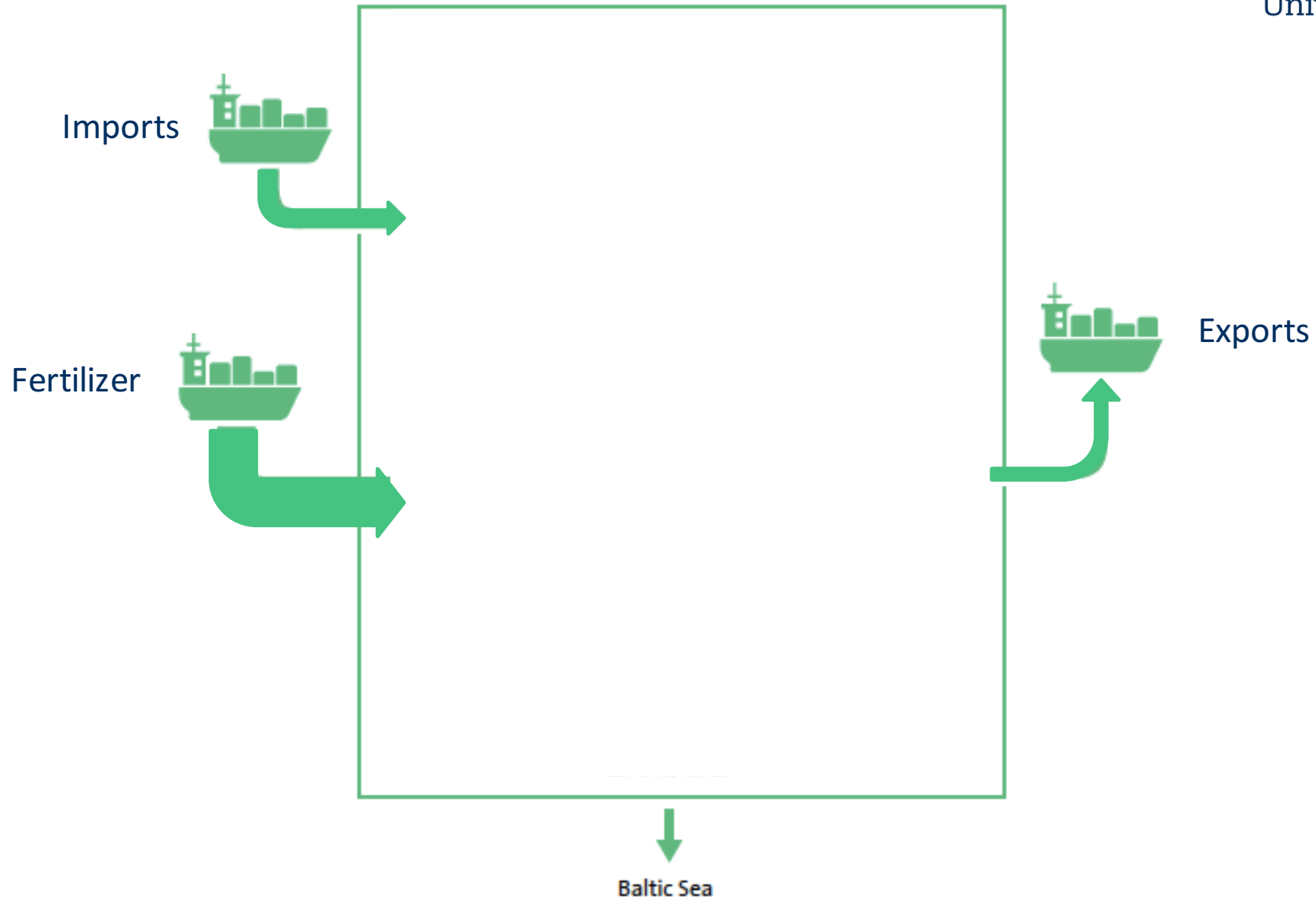

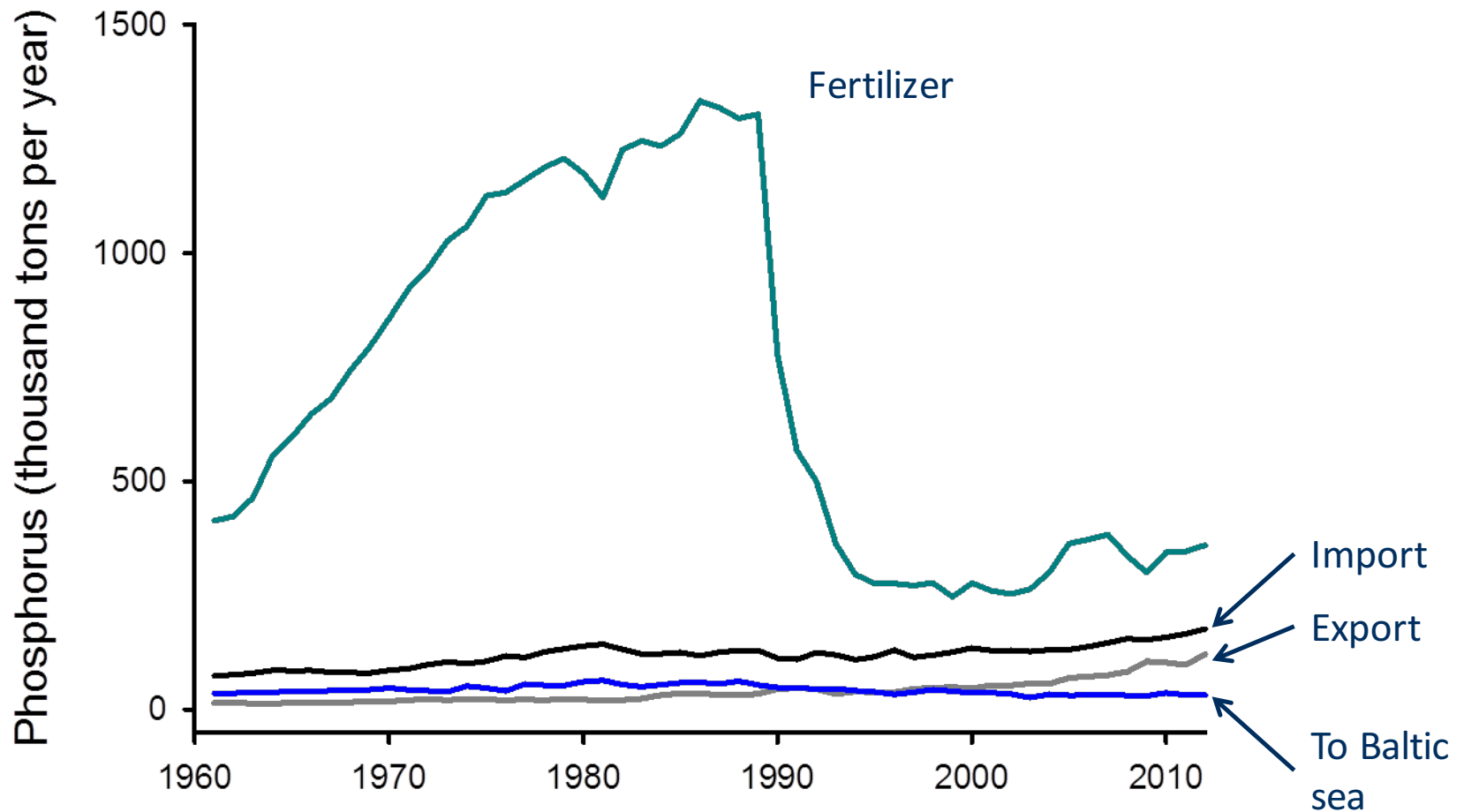
External phosphorus loads have halved



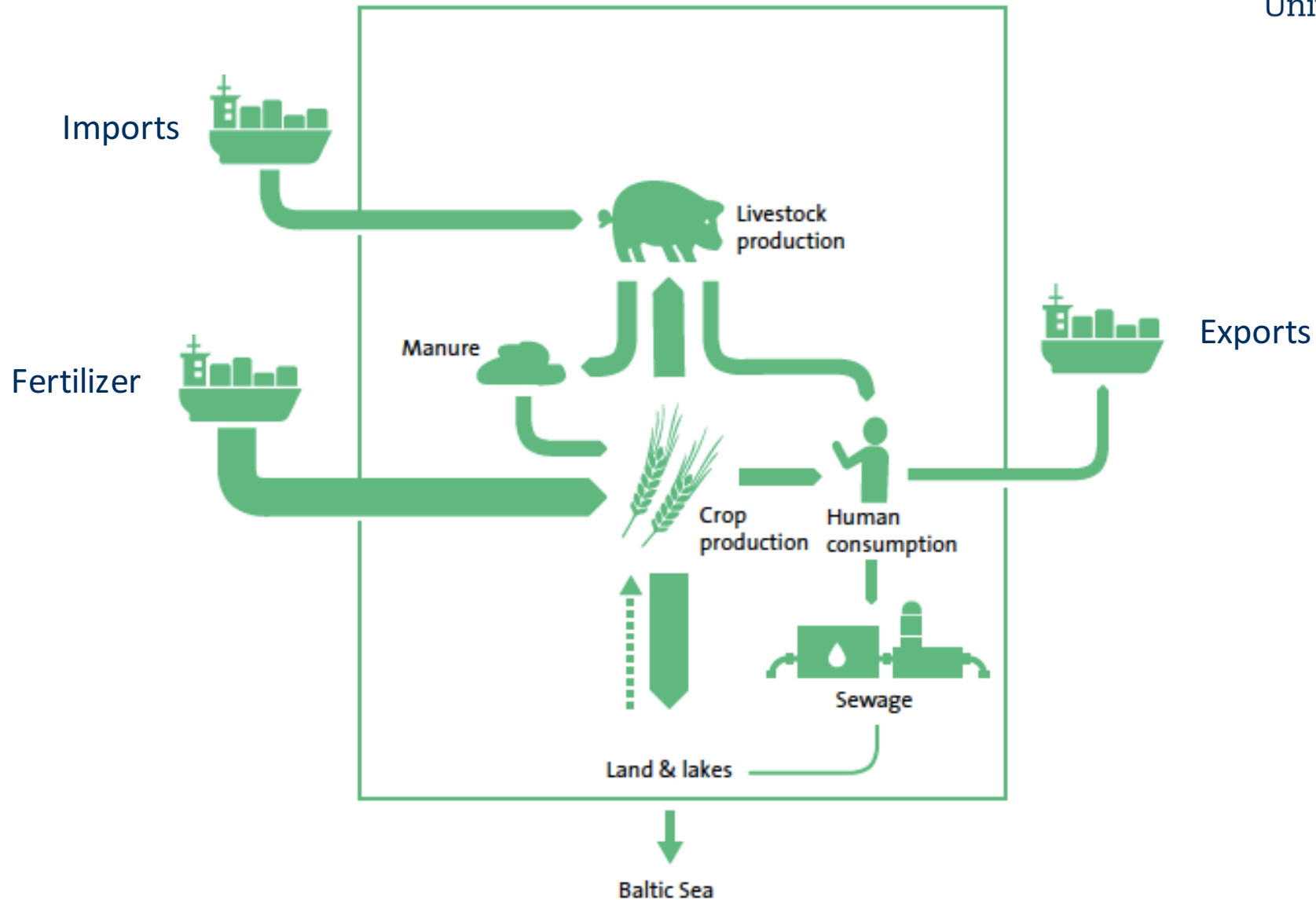
Flows of phosphorus

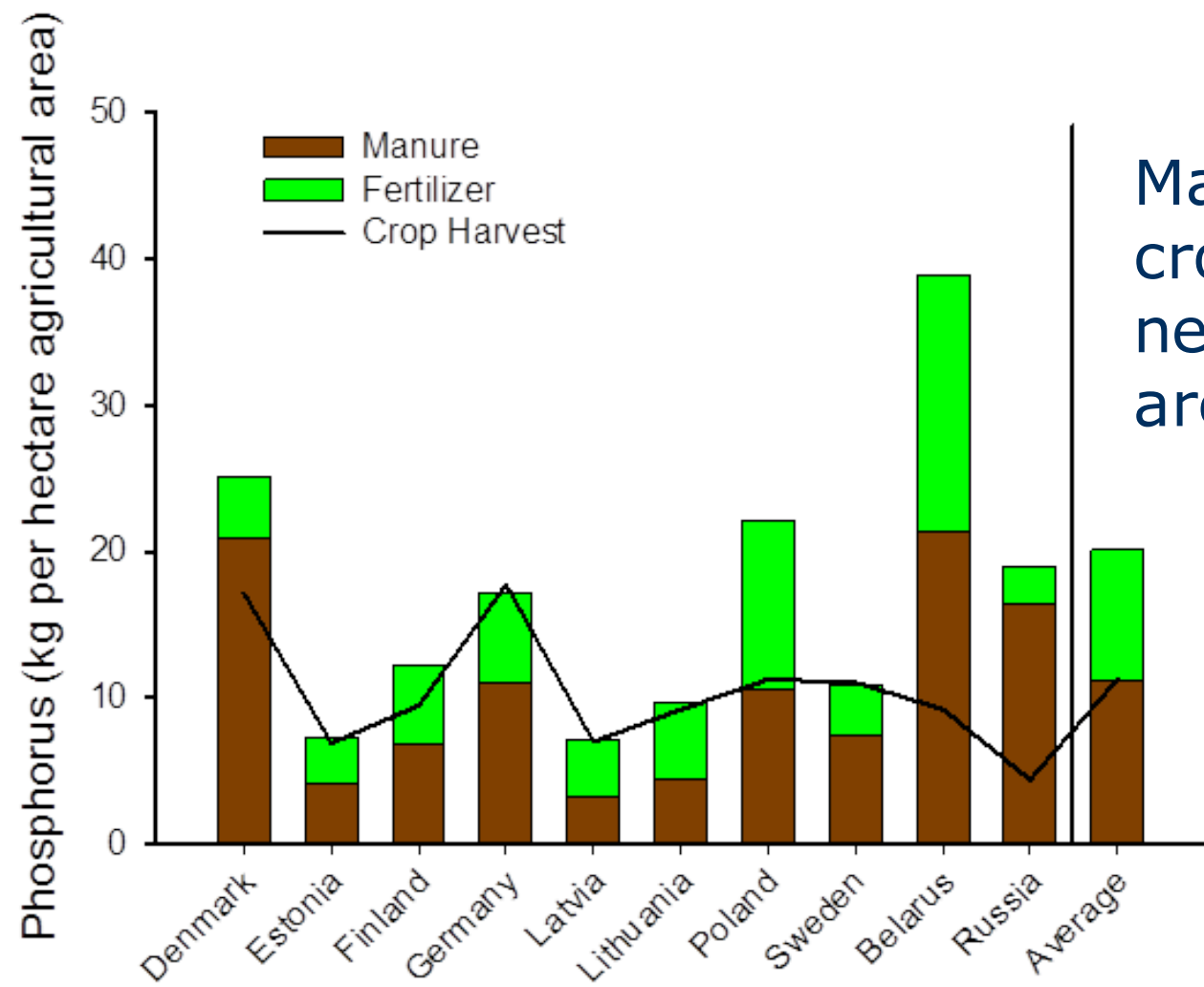


Accumulation on land: 40 million tons in 50 years



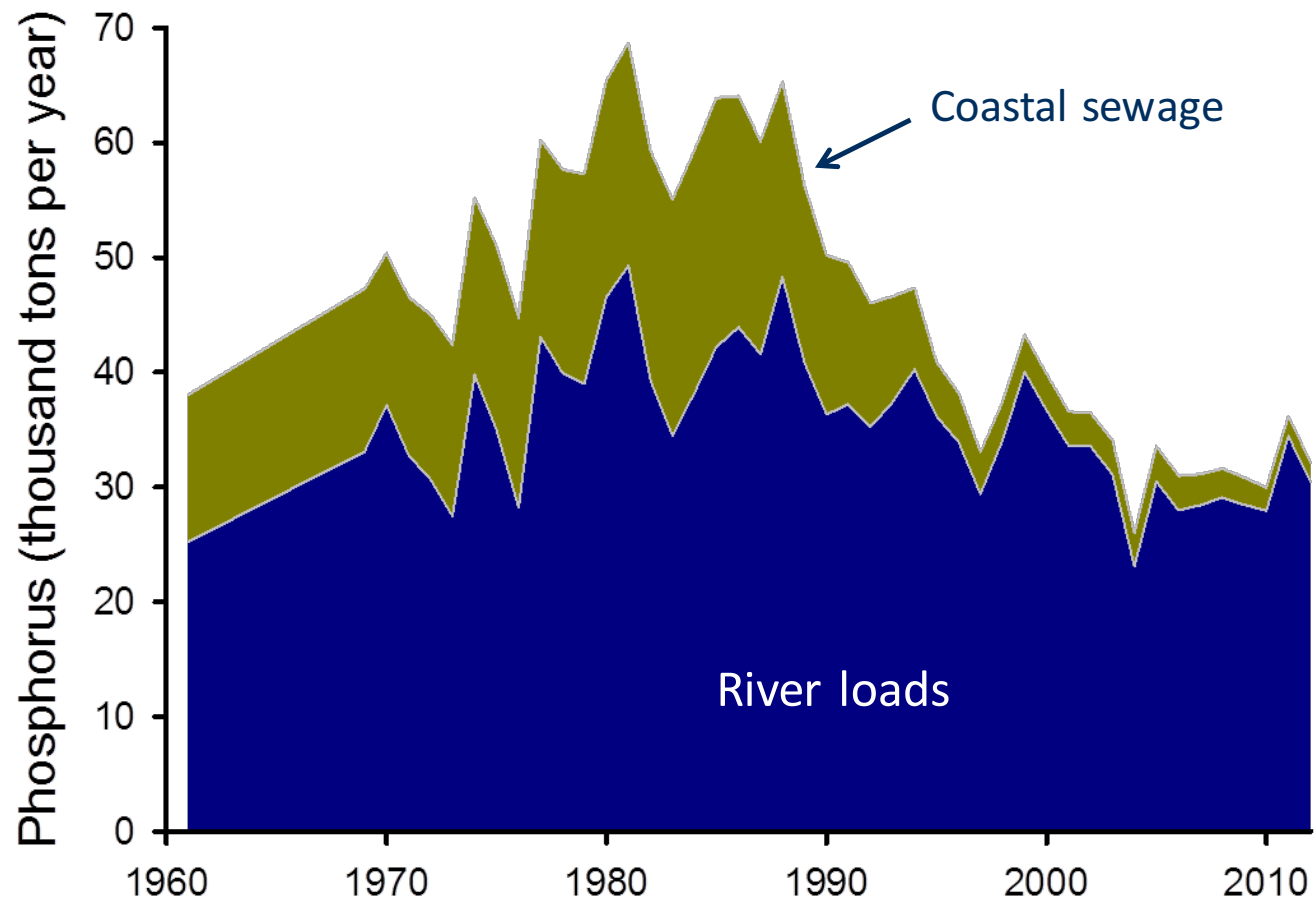
Phosphorus flows on land
