We wish all Bolin Centre members a good start into 2019 and already now we look forward to one of the Bolin year's highlights - the Climate Festival in May.

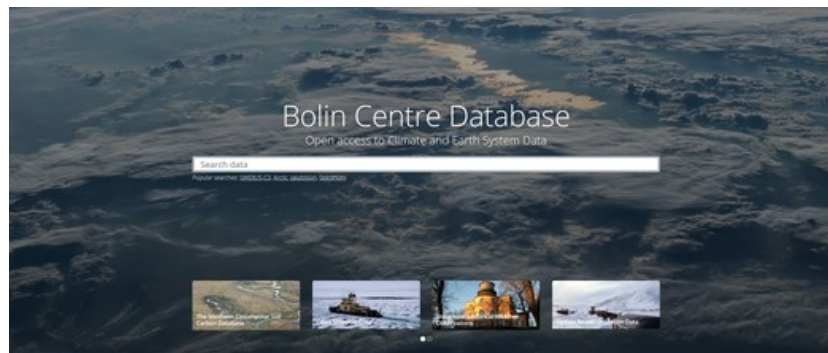
