In Swedish | Klimatförändringar gör vissa väderprognoser svårare

De pågående klimatförändringarna gör det svårare att förutspå vissa aspekter av vädret, visar en ny studie från Bolincenterforskare vid Meteorologiska institutionen, Stockholms universitet. Studien gäller väderprognoser på 3–10 dagars sikt i norra hemisfären och störst osäkerhet uppstår när det gäller förmågan att förutspå regnmängder under sommarhalvåret, något som kan få stor betydelse för beredskapen inför översvämningar.
