New datasets in the Bolin Centre Database

27 + 3 new datasets are available at the Bolin Centre Database. Three entirely new ones:

- Late-glacial European summer temperature reconstruction. Frederik Schenk, <https://bolin.su.se/data/schenk-2018>
- CTD data from the SWERUS-C3 expedition 2014 in the Arctic Ocean. Göran Björk, <https://bolin.su.se/data/bjork-2018>
- Carbon use efficiency from organisms to ecosystems. Stefano Manzoni, <https://bolin.su.se/data/manzoni-2018>

Also, twenty-seven datasets from the Arctic Summer Cloud Ocean Study (ASCOS) expedition in 2008, which was deployed on the Swedish icebreaker Oden, have now been fully incorporated in our database. They were already previously available as part of a thematic presentation on the database website, but they are now also fully searchable as individual datasets.
