FN:s klimatpanel IPCC arbetar just nu med att ta fram två specialrapporter; en om klimatförändringar och marken, samt en om klimatförändringar, havet och kryosfären. Det är nu dags för en andra granskningsomgång och experter som vill delta i granskningen är välkomna att anmäla sitt intresse för att delta i rapporternas framtagande som granskare.

Om ni granskar rapporterna och vill dela med er av era synpunkter till oss på Sveriges kontaktpunkt för IPCC så skulle vi vara mycket tacksamma för detta, eftersom vi då har möjlighet att också ta med era synpunkter i det svar som Sverige (vi som regeringsrepresentanter) skickar in. I så fall behöver vi era synpunkter senast en vecka innan den formella deadline för respektive granskning.
