## Agreement: Visiting PhD students in the Stockholm Doctoral Course Program in Economics, Econometrics and Finance (SDPE)

- (1) PhD students enrolled in the SDPE can spend part of their studies as a *visiting student* at another institution (henceforth host institution) within the SDPE collaboration than the one they were initially admitted to (henceforth home institution).
- (2) To make use of this opportunity, students must (i) apply to the host institution they would like to be admitted to as visiting student and (ii) be admitted as visiting student by the host institution.
- (3) The following rules apply
  - a. Visiting students continuous to be PhD students at the home institution.
  - b. Visiting students continuous to have their main supervisors at the home institution.
  - c. Visiting students must have at least one co-supervisor at the host institution.
  - d. Visiting students shall on average spend two days per week at the home institution and three days a week at the host institution.
  - e. Visiting students continuous to be financed by the home institution for two additional years after being admitted as visiting student if admitted after one or two years of studies in the program, and for one additional year after being admitted as visiting student if admitted after three years of studies. Thereafter, until graduation, visiting students are financed by the host institution.
- (4) Visiting students can at any time terminate their position as visiting student. In that case rules stated under (3) no longer apply.
- (5) In individual cases, deviations from this agreement may occur if agreed upon by the head/director of the home and of the host institution.
