## Fall Call 2020

The Arctic Avenue fall call is now open! Application **deadline** is **October 20.** Specific information for the call and application form »

# Smaller funding

The Arctic Avenue offers its members to submit smaller applications for funding throughout the year. These cannot exceed 1000 € per project, and will be up to the co-leaders discretion to decide on. The application can have the same format as the fall call 2020.



## Extension of funding

We have stated before that all successful applications must use their funds within 12 months from receiving a positive funding decision. We do however recognize that delays might be expected due to the current Corona pandemic. If so, deadlines for using Arctic Avenue funding will be extended.
