# ARCTIC AVENUE



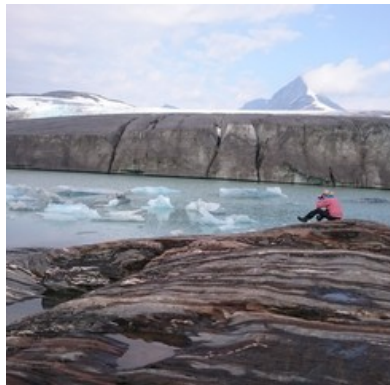
## Welcome to the second annual meeting, August 10-11, 2020

Due to the ongoing Corona pandemic, we are unfortunately forced to cancel the second annual Arctic Avenue meeting in Kilpisjärvi, which was scheduled for August 10-12. While the station is planned to be opened gradually over the summer, uncertainties related to travelling and possible quarantines are too high to continue planning for a physical meeting.

INSTEAD, we will host a virtual Zoom-meeting on the planned dates, more specifically August 10-11, at 10-12 and 13-16 pm each day. The virtual meeting will consist of an overview of Arctic Avenue activities to date, keynote lectures, short talks presenting first results of the many ongoing Arctic Avenue projects, and plans for next steps to be taken.

We are planning to have a physical meeting at Kilpisjärvi in August 2021.
