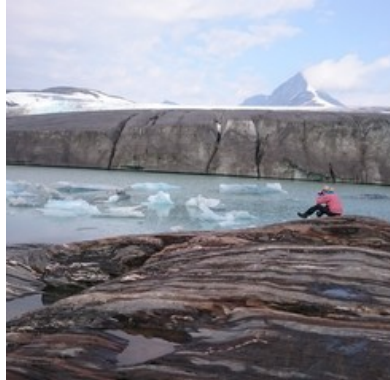
Dear members of Arctic Avenue,
