

Stockholm University's Policy for Meetings and Travel

These are the main features of the University's policy for meetings and travel. The policy aims to minimise the climate impact of Stockholm University. The policy in its entirety is available at su.se/travelpolicy.

Is the Trip Necessary?

- Evaluate the need for every work or study related trip.

Digital Alternative?

- As far as possible, travelling should be replaced by digital forms of meetings.
- Flying to a meeting or an activity lasting less than one workday is not allowed if digital participation can be offered.

Ground-Based Alternatives?

- Modes of transportation generating low amounts of greenhouse gas emissions should be prioritised – such as rail over air travel.

Avoid Air Travel Less than 700 Kilometers

- Unless there are special circumstances, journeys shorter than 700 kilometers should be made by other means than air travel..

Prioritise Public Transport

- For local travel in Sweden and abroad, public transport should be prioritised, followed by taxis (eco-certified) or other modes of ground transportation with low carbon emissions.
