Monday IGV notes by Magnus Mörrth, February 5, 2024

1. **The universities economy** is good although there is a deficit in humsam faculty. In total the deficit was 60 million, but our faculty had a surplus. The program economy in balance was mainly for the humsam faculty as we are doing well.
2. As an employee or student at the university, **report incidents**, i.e., events that have resulted in or could potentially lead to harm to individuals, property, or the external environment. It may also include events or behaviours that could harm the university's operations or violate applicable laws and regulations. When reporting an incident in the IA system, your manager and the faculty's work environment coordinator are notified. The main safety representative and work environment representative also become aware of the incident. There are different ways to report an event/deviation, either by using one of the following links or through the IA app.

Rapportera händelser/avvikelser via app

För att rapportera en händelse via IA-appen behöver du först ladda ner appen med din mobiltelefon via Google Play (Android) eller App Store (iPhone). Sen behöver du logga in manuellt med följande uppgifter:

Report incidents/deviations via the app.

To report an incident via the IA app, you first need to download the app on your mobile phone from Google Play (Android) or the App Store (iPhone). Then, you need to log in manually with the following details:

Användare/User: SUapp

Lösenord/Password: Februari2022

3. **Ongoing phishing** attempt directed at SU
A phishing attempt is circulating and has reached many of us. The email appears to come from Postnord. If you have received it, do not click on any links, discard the email immediately.
4. Update on **PRIMULA**

5. We recently got the **result from the Employee survey** 'Harassment, sexual harassment and abusive discrimination' for the science faculty and SU. In general, it looks like other academic environments in Sweden, but a zero vision is the objective.

We will get Erika from the HR to visit us, and she will present the survey result in the near future.

6. SciLifeLab

I also got a presentation recently about SciLifeLab and SciLifeLab at SU recently. In all the government and Wallenberg foundation put in 1 billion per year that is for infrastructure, data driven life sciences, research - special research areas (SFO). At SU about 45 million per year is distributed into this area and that money goes mainly go to the fellows program.

It is not decided yet about the proposals for new areas will be, but we will know shortly. IGV has suggested one area together with ACES, Zoologi and DEEP.

7. I reported about the **Anthropocene laboratory** previously and this week it will be inaugurated.

Tomorrow, the new Anthropocene Laboratory at the Academy of Sciences is inaugurated. It is a major investment in research in sustainability financed by the Marianne and Marcus Wallenberg Foundation and the Marcus and Amalia Wallenberg Memorial Foundation. It will be placed at KVA just across the street.

8. Remember to do a **risk assessment of all laboratory and field work**. If you are taking any chemicals in the field this must be risk assessed, contact SEKA miljöteknik to get the help needed to complete such an assessment.
