- Rektors prefektmöten 3rd April 2025: first meeting with the new Rektor Hans Adolfsson. Some SU-wide topics presented:
 - -AI- impact on university teaching (increasing incidents found: plagiarism, false references, obvious rapid improvements in students grammar/writing, vague or over detailed answers. Formal reported cases have increased.
 - -Information security: New US IT cyber security chef: Frederik Bolinder, IT avdelningen. Beware of 'Ransomware'!
 - -SFOs: Nya Strategiska ForskningsOmråden
 - -New priority research areas were identified by the government end 2024 (includes research on 'climate' and 'polar regions').
 - -Stage 1: Feb/March 2025 . Thirteen suggestions were submitted by SU
 - -Stage 2: SU decides which ones should go forward, how to merge
 - -Climate-related: 3, Polar-focused: 2, 6 bridge between polar and climate
 - -Other suggestions from Humanities and law areas at SU.

- Two projects funded by SGU Sveriges geologiska undersökning
 - Alasdair Skelton, Paola Manzotti, Christophe Du Praz and Joakim Mansfeld, Svecofennian Laboratory: Enhance understanding of the Svecofennian bedrock by studying critical raw materials, fieldwork in the Stockholm archipelago. Societal relevance.
 - 2. Iain Pitcairn: *Skarn-type REE Mineralisation*: Magnetite as a potential indicator for rare earth element (REE) deposits, REE mineralisation processes. Fieldwork in northern Sweden, high societal relevance, complements ongoing PhD work.

• New instrument at IGV: Desk top SEM, with EDS & a Gold sputter-coater. Set-up on floor 3 (Gamma Data, Uppsala). User friendly, a fantastic tool for imaging and geochemical analysis. 6 months initial set up time. Then will be made available to IGV users generally with small user fees.
